Week 4 Autumn 1 2024



Well done to our EYFS friends for another full week of school - we have had a few Super Suns on our daily challenge and everyone is trying hard. We are so proud of all of them.

They are now getting used to our daily routines and timetable and were introduced to the daily maths sessions we do.

They enjoyed our PSED time with Jigsaw Jenny and we played a game to help them get to know the names of all the children in their year group.

The children have also been introduced to phonics time in which they will learn the sounds and names of the letters and then begin to learn to blend them together to read words. They have brought home this half term's phonemes to practise with information on games to play at home and a sheet explaining the correct pronunciation and grapheme formation. Don't worry all will be explained at the Reading meetings on the 7th or 9th of October, but do come and ask if you have any questions.

We have started looking at nursery rhymes and the children are working on their own nursery rhyme book. They have also been creating with a nursery rhyme theme. They each made a spider web plate that they have taken home to share and have been practising their creating and colouring skills by drawing their own Humpty Dumpty to go in our class nursery rhyme book.

In topic this week we looked at all the different dinosaurs and then the children decorated their own 3D model dinosaur which they named and then took home.

They also took part in some senses experiments to find out about our senses of hearing, touch, taste and smell.

The children took part in a session with the Year 1 children from Tigers and Leopards where they got to try out different ways of fastening paper together.
