EYFS Tigers

Week 7 Autumn 1 2024

Well done everyone on another good week - we have been looking at shapes this week. The children have been recognizing 2D shapes around us and learning their names and beginning to think about their properties. They have also had fun exploring 3D shapes, using them to build models and discussing their names and again exploring their properties - finding out which roll, slide and which can stack easily.

On Monday the EYFS children were part of a great welcome to potential new EYFS parents for September 2025, who having listened to a presentation, were then having a look around Tiger classroom. The children were a real credit to you and us with their great behaviour and welcoming smiles.

As part of our 'Dino Roar' topic the children have all painted a picture of either a dragon, dinosaur or princess - do come and have a look, these are hanging in Tiger class for you to enjoy. Once dried the children then had a go at writing a simple sentence about their picture, this was a great opportunity to talk about what writing is and what it is made up of. They all had a fantastic try.

This week's phonics has introduced the first digraph (two letters that make one sound) to the children - ck and they have now been introduced to 16 phonemes. We continue to work on listening to the initial sounds in words and beginning to learn the process of blending phonemes to make simple words. The children really love their phonic sessions which also include being introduced to the correct formation of these graphemes.

The children had great fun in music with Miss Grant, the frog on the pond is a very popular game.

Friday was 'Wear Red' with the idea of raising awareness about diversity and the need to show racism the red card. The children enjoyed seeing everyone wearing red.
