Week 3 Autumn 2 2024

This week we continued to find out about the story of Diwali, learning about the story of Rama and Sita. The children retold the story through sequencing a set of pictures and then describing to each other what was happening in each picture. They acted out the story in groups and then took part in a whole class reenactment in the hall, we used their paper diva lamps to help light the way home for Rama and Sita.

The children continue on their reading journeys as they learn to recognize the sight (tricky) words, to recognize the letters and blend them (sound talk) to make words. They continue to learn about the letter formation and all of this is being seen in their developing writing. We are so proud of the progress they are all making and their enthusiasm for having a go at writing is so great to see.

In numeracy the children continue to focus on the composition of numbers to 3, playing lots of games to help them recognize, count, subitise and order numbers to 3. We have also been looking at patterns through following Diwali and firework patterns and been recapping 2d shapes - recognising, naming and beginning to think about their properties.

We continued looking at the season of Autumn and the children looked at the different clothes we wear in different seasons. It has been a tricky week with some unseasonably cold weather including black ice and snow which can be a little confusing when you start to learn about our seasons and weather!

We have started to learn the songs for the upcoming Nativity - don't forget to save the dates - Tuesday 10th or Wednesday 11th December. Details of how to get tickets will be out soon.
