The children have enjoyed being able to get out and about more this week as things return to a more normal Winter. They were able to draw on their experiences of Winter from last week to talk about the many different things that happen in Winter. They worked in groups with an adult to write down their ideas and then used these to write a group poem about Winter. They then illustrated their ideas on giant snowflakes. They also learnt how to make paper snowflakes. Do come and see all of this on the Winter display in Tigers and also in their Winter poem book in the reading area. There are other books in the reading corner which they have written as a group, all of which helps them see themselves as authors!

We continued to explore the Wintry theme with the children working as a group to explore how to free some toy animals and cars from 2 ice blocks. They worked as a team thinking up ideas - as always they had great ideas involving ovens, spades or the sun! Luckily they came up with some slightly more practical ways to melt the ice. Do ask your child what worked best.

The children made themselves a twirling snowman by using their cutting skills and following a simple set of instructions.

The children have also had great fun in the newly arrived role play airport and aeroplane. They have been using the passports they made and found out about the different roles in an airport and on board a plane. They are now set to travel the world looking for some of those exciting habitats they are going to be learning about in their topic.
