### **Week 3 Spring 1 2025**

The children continue to work hard on their writing, talking about what writing is and what they need to do to write. They are linking their growing phonic knowledge to their writing and have had lots of practice. They have been writing about their weekends and pictures of birds feeding. They have also had great fun listening to Julia Donaldson's story 'The Gruffalo', and writing about their favourite part of the story. They then used their own imaginations to create their own terrible creature.

In topic this week we looked at Polar habitats and the children found out about some of the animals that live there and how they adapt to such cold habitats. The children identified some of the common animals we find in the polar habitats and they created a polar scene by cutting and sticking.

We took part in the RSPB Big School Birdwatch on Thursday with our Year 1 friends from Tigers and Leopards. We had had many birds visiting the replenished bird feeders in our garden over the past week and we were lucky on the day despite rather wet weather as we spotted lots of different birds. We entered our results onto the RSPB website and look forward to hearing how other schools got on with this event. The children also made their own rocking bird to take home and played games to help them identify some of the birds that are native to the UK. The children also made themselves a robin mask to take home and a recycled bird feeder to hang outside at home. They really enjoyed spotting the birds and would love to have a try over the coming weekend at home. They brought home an extra sheet to have a go with their family.

In PSED this week we have been looking at the importance of listening and working on this throughout our lessons to help us learn how to listen and focus. We played some fun games to help us with our listening skills.

In maths this week we are continuing to look into the composition of numbers - finding out how to make up a number using different numbers. This week it has been all about the number 6.

We continue to work hard on the letter formation in our names and learning about the different families of letters.
