Our collective worship value this term is 'perseverance' we have been talking about what this means, the children have all shown this value in the snowman puppets they have made over the past couple of weeks. They have had to show perseverance in being able to sew their puppet - they were all very proud of the results - do pop and see them at Open Door next week.

In maths this week we used our growing knowledge and understanding of numbers to play various counting games and also started to learn all about the number 7.

We continue to work hard learning about the different families of letters, this week the children have been practicing the 'curly caterpillar' family and learning about the 'ladder letter' family. They have also been using their growing knowledge of writing letters and linking this to their phonics, listening to phonemes and writing their corresponding graphemes.

In our topic this week we learnt about life in Desert regions (the driest parts of our world) and talked about what it would feel like there, what we might wear and what it would look like. We also learnt about some of the animals that live in deserts and then created a picture to show some of these animals.

We also found out about Lunar New Year (also known as Chinese New Year), we learnt about how children prepare for this special event and what they do to celebrate. We also learnt about the story of how each year gets its name - this coming year is the Year of the Snake. The children had great fun making themselves a spinning snake plate decoration - they have come on so well with their cutting skills.
