The children have been working on our collective worship value 'Perseverance', as part of this work they followed instructions to create a snowman picture, it wasn't easy but the results were great - do come and have a look on our class display. They have also been thinking about our Tiger class rules and why rules are important. They have helped write a set of rules which help make Tigers such a great place to learn and have fun in.

In science they have been learning about the adaptations different animals make in Winter to keep themselves fed and warm. They looked at animals that migrate or hibernate and those animals that adapt their appearance or behaviour.

This week also saw the children finding out about 'Lunar New Year' (it is also known as Chinese New Year, though now called Lunar to acknowledge the fact that it is more widely celebrated than just in China). They watched a video showing two children preparing for this special celebration and then celebrating with their families. We talked about the similarities and differences between this and the celebrations they are more familiar with. We also looked at the story behind the zodiac calendar and how each year got its name. They then wrote about this story, focussing on the parts they enjoyed the most. Alongside all these activities they have continued working hard on their other subjects including their phonics and spellings with great attitudes in the spelling test! They have enjoyed their PE lesson with Leopards and done some amazing maths this week, super focus and attention.

They continue to be great role models to the younger members of Tiger class and should be very proud of themselves. This is such an important role and they are helping to fill the class kindness jar which we hope to fill before Easter.
