Week 6 Autumn 1 2025

Well done everyone on another good week - we have been looking at measuring this week. The children have been exploring the language of measuring with regard length and height. We had great fun measuring everyone and putting us all into height order and then focused on learning about the words longer and shorter. Do see if you can practise using these words this week at home!

On Monday the EYFS children were part of a great welcome to potential new EYFS parents for September 2026, who having listened to a presentation, were then having a look around Tiger classroom. The children were a real credit to you and us with their great behaviour and welcoming smiles.

As part of our 'Dino Roar' topic the children have all painted a picture of either a dragon, dinosaur or princess - do come and have a look, these are hanging in Tiger class for you to enjoy. Once dried the children then had a go at writing a simple sentence about their picture, this was a great opportunity to talk about what writing is and what it is made up of. They all had a fantastic try.

The children also looked at which things were real or pretend when looking at princesses, dragons and dinosaurs. Do have a look at their work in their learning journeys.

They had great fun creating their very own senses monster, these are hanging up in Tigers - pop in and have a look!

This week's phonics has introduced the first digraph (two letters that make one sound) to the children - ck and they have now been introduced to 16 phonemes. We continue to work on listening to the initial sounds in words and beginning to learn the process of blending phonemes to make simple words. The children really love their phonic sessions which also include being introduced to the correct formation of these graphemes.
