EYFS have had a lovely week finishing off our topic 'Dino-Roar', the children chose their favourite part of the topic to share with their friends. They have also been looking at sorting and the language of position in maths.

The Year 1 children finished their topic on 'Knights and castles' by finding out about the knights code of chivalry and then creating their own, they also learnt about the knights armour and created their own coat of arms. They have also been consolidating their maths and phonics this week and have been amazed at how much they have learnt in such a relatively short time.

We all celebrated the festival of Diwali this week, finding out lots about this special Hindu and Sikh celebration. We talked about how there are lots of similarities to some of our Christian celebrations and also how things might differ. The children all made some lovely Rangoli patterns using stencils and sand or paint, the EYFS created a paper diva lamp and the Year 1 children made a Rangoli pattern paper lantern. They all really enjoyed listening to and watching the story of Rama and Sita and finding out how people helped guide them home using the diva lamps. We got to act out the story as a class which was great fun.

We finished the week with some pumpkin carving fun alongside exploring the seeds to see how they felt and smelt.
