The children have settled back well after half term, getting back into the routines and carrying on with their learning journeys.

The children have started their new topic 'Twinkle Sparkle' which is based on the many festivals and celebrations that happen over this next term.

We have started the topic by looking at this week's celebration of Bonfire Night. The children found out about Guy Fawkes and why we have this celebration and what people do to celebrate. We also talked about firework safety. They made themselves a twisting paper rocket and then followed a pattern to make a 3D shape rocket using a cylinder and a cone. These rockets could be held by their string and made to whizz around! The children worked with their Year 1 friends to create a pretend bonfire in our yard and they all had great fun pretending to celebrate bonfire night!

The children also started looking at the 4 seasons we have in this country and took part in a game to sort different activities from during the year.

We started the new phonemes, a pack of which has been put in the children's plastic wallets to help them practise at home.

The children have also been checking on our fundraising ideas for Children in Need. Parents have been sent a letter with plans for a toy and book sale, a games fair and cake bake - all happening next week. The children also brought home a sponsor form in preparation for our sponsored walk on Tuesday to Chatsworth.
