Another busy week in Tigers.

The children started this busy week by taking part in a balance bike activity, they got to practise balancing when moving, learning how to stop and to manoeuvre around objects. They also each iced a biscuit (kindly made by Mrs Booth and Miss Pettett) ready for the sponsored walk the next day.

On Tuesday they took part in a sponsored walk to Chatsworth with the Year 1 and 2's in aid of Children in Need. We were very lucky with the weather and the children all did amazingly well. We were met in Chatsworth grounds by Mrs Shore, who had a hot chocolate drink and their iced biscuit ready and waiting for them (thank you Mrs Shore!), after a short play they managed the walk back (if a little slower!).

In between all this excitement we also spent time helping them to begin to understand Remembrance Day and why we have this special day. The EYFS children made themselves a splodge poppy and a split pin poppy. They took part in a whole class 'Big Art' project using their own bodies to create a large-scale poppy outside in the Infant garden. The children also took part in the 2-minute silence both when on our sponsored walk and later with the rest of the school whilst listening to Helen play her cornet.

We continue to learn more phonemes and are all working hard on blending these sounds to make words. The children are also busy learning sight words (Tricky Words) which can't be read using their phonic knowledge but need to be learnt as a whole word. The children are enjoying reading their group books which link to their phonics.

We have also been thinking about the season of Autumn and the children worked together in groups to think about things we see and do in Autumn. They will use these next week to create group poems about Autumn.

The children finished the week by taking part in our EYFS and KS1 enterprise fund raising for Children in Need, they made themselves a Pudsey badge to wear and came to school wearing a range of Pudsey clothes! In the afternoon they helped run the book and toy stalls and then had a go on the games run by the Year 1s and 2s. A huge thanks to the parents from Tigers and Leopards who then also ran a cake bake after school with all money raised going to the Children in Need collection. We will let you know how much was raised overall. It is an important event as not only is it fun but also helps the children to think about helping others outside of our class, which again are important lessons for life.

A huge thanks to all those EYFS parents who managed to come to the maths/ PSED meetings this week, we do appreciate it isn't always easy to attend and have sent home all the information.
