### **Week 3 Autumn 2 2025**

Tiger class enjoyed a slightly quieter week this week after the excitement of last week. We can't quite believe how much was raised for Children in Need, a huge thank you to everyone for all your support in raising £2724.70. A truly remarkable amount!

We have continued to look at the season of Autumn, thinking about the different clothes that we wear in different seasons. It has been a tricky week with some unseasonably cold weather including black ice and even snow on surrounding high grounds, which can be a little confusing when you start to learn about our seasons and weather. We used the ideas we had gathered last week about the signs of Autumn and worked in groups to make Autumn poems. The children then illustrated their poems, all of which can be seen in their class book. They were very proud of their role as authors and illustrators. The children have also enjoyed some Autumn art with Autumn leaf window hangings and printing Autumn leaves with potato prints.

The children continue on their reading journeys as they learn to recognize the sight (tricky) words, to recognize the letters and blend them (sound talk) to make words. They continue to learn about the letter formation and all of this is being seen in their developing writing. We are so proud of the progress they are all making and their enthusiasm for having a go at writing is so great to see. Do come in and have a look at their Early Morning Activity books where they have been practicing their independent writing skills.

In numeracy the children started to focus on the composition of numbers to 4, playing lots of games to help them recognize, count, subitise and order numbers to 4. We have also been looking at patterns through following firework patterns.

We have started to learn the songs for the upcoming Nativity - don't forget to save the dates - Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> December. Details of how to get tickets will be out soon.
