The children have enjoyed being able to get out and about more this week as things return to a more normal Winter. They were able to draw on their experiences of Winter from last week to talk about the many different things that happen in Winter.

They then worked in groups with an adult to write down their ideas and then used these to write group poems about Winter. They then illustrated their ideas on giant snowflakes. Do come and see their Winter poem book in the reading area. There are other books in the reading corner which they have written as a group, all of which helps them see themselves as authors!

We continue to explore the Wintery theme with the children working as a group to explore how to free some toy animals and cars from 2 ice blocks. They worked as a team thinking up ideas - as always they had great ideas involving ovens, spades or the sun! Luckily they also came up with some slightly more practical ways to melt ice Do ask your child what worked best.

The children made themselves a twirling snowman by using their cutting skills and following a simple set of instructions.

The children wrote a sentence to go with their super Winter paintings and these are displayed in the classroom.

The children welcomed a new addition to our EYFS group, they were all super kind and helpful and our new friend has settled in really well.

We started our new topic 'Where in the world we will find a polar bear?' by finding out what a habitat is and starting to think about what animals are found where.
