They completed their topic cover and wrote their own question.

In science they have started on this terms topic on 'Animals (including humans)' by again pooling their knowledge about animals, many of them knew that humans are included in this. They then looked at the human body and worked together to label a giant drawing of a child and label their own sheet for their books.

The Year 1s in Tigers have helped make a lovely display of all the children in Tigers, with a painting of themselves and a speech bubble explaining who they are and what they like to do.

They have been role modelling being a good friend for our new EYFS friends and talked to them about what they think makes good friends at school.

In Maths this week they have been busy recapping numbers to 20, they have been ordering numbers starting at random numbers, alongside recapping their number formation and learning number words.

A big thank you for helping them with their spellings at home, this really helps consolidate that phonic work done in school.

We couldn't be prouder of how hard they are working and the great attitudes they are displaying to their work and to being those role models. We know this will continue next week as our new EYFS friends start full time.
