This week has been 'National Storytelling Week' and the children have been introduced to our class puppet Grandad. He has been retelling some of his favourite traditional tales. They have really enjoyed listening to his storytelling and all his voices and expression - skills they will develop on their own reading journeys. We then worked in groups to create their own exciting stories. The children made up their stories which an adult scribed, they then drew a picture to go with their story. Do come and see their story in our class book in the reading corner with their other class books. They also painted a picture of their favourite traditional story character and wrote about this character. They are working on creating their own story and started by choosing and making their very own split pin character.

The children continue to work hard learning about the different families of letters, this week being introduced to the 'robot arm' family. They are also all working so hard on writing their names using correct formation, sizing and positioning. We are so proud of how well they are doing with this.

The children also continued their work on Winter, thinking about the four different seasons and what these seasons bring.

In topic this week we continued our work on habitats by looking at rainforest habitats. The children found out where these are found (near the equator) and then created a rainforest scene by cutting and sticking.

In maths this week we have been looking at number formation and continued working on our numbers - reciting numbers up to and down from 20 as well as practising our 1 to 1 correspondence when counting.

In PE we have continued exploring gymnastics through finding different ways of travelling using different parts of our bodies.

The children continue to enjoy our outside learning area, building and creating with our large apparatus and bringing their imaginations into play.

The children love their weekly music lessons with our music specialist Miss Grant, having great fun whilst also learning lots of new music language.
