

# CLASS 3 NEWSLETTER

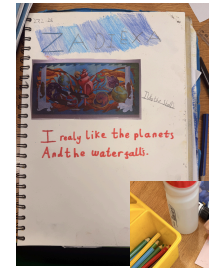
## SPRING 2, WEEK 1
