Another fun packed week with lots of excitement!

We have been finding out about Mother's Day, what it is and why we celebrate it, we talked about all the fantastic things our mums do to help us. We made a flower card and planted a bulb alongside a stick flower to give to our mums on Sunday.

On Wednesday we went to see the 'Living Eggs' that are housed in Lions this year - we saw the ten eggs in the incubator - though four chicks had already hatched - three girls and one boy. You can tell by the colour of the chick. We are looking forward to learning more about these next week.

We have been celebrating British Science Week - the theme this year is curiosity, we have been thinking about things we would like to find out about. The children have thought about what science is and what a scientist does and over the week they have taken part in lots of different activities and experiments and been scientists themselves. They had great fun making cornflour slime which was very messy but great fun! They also took part in a variety of other experiments which included seeing if you can change the size of a sweet by putting it in water, what happens if you add water to sugar coated sweets and could they make a rainbow bubble! There were lots of great predictions and some surprising results. We also got to see the results of the cress experiment we had set up last week. The seeds that had water, light and soil all grew as they should, what surprised the children was that the ones with water and soil but no light still grew (though not the expected colour). The children recorded the results on their prediction sheet - do pop in and see these in their science book. The children then planted two giant sunflower seeds in a pot to take home. They will need some help to take care of them and we look forward to seeing if they grow! Do send us in some photos if they survive into the summer.

We have had fun with our story 'Jack and the Beanstalk' joining in with the repeating refrains and remembering how the story is ordered. We looked at the life cycle of a bean and watched a video showing how it grows from a seed to a plant.

We have been exploring measurements in maths finding out about height and length and the appropriate language we use. We continue to practise our letter formation, alongside our phonics and reading skills.

We also really enjoyed our visit from 'Fizz Pop' who came to do science activities with the whole school, we got to enjoy the whole school assembly about air it was very exciting, we even saw a child move across the hall on a hover board! In Tigers we had a fantastic time learning about bubbles and even got to take home a mini bubble wand to continue the fun.
