We continued looking at our new topic 'Our Wonderful World' as we went on another walk around the bottom end of Baslow, this helped us find out about more of the different features we can see in our beautiful environment.

In maths the children have been looking at weight and capacity and had great fun using the sand to help embed these areas.

The children are working on their sizing and position in their handwriting using the extra lines in their handwriting books.

We celebrated World Earth Day - thinking about what we love about our world and learning about ways we can help look after it. The children then worked as a group to make an acrostic poem about our amazing world.

We learnt about the patron saint of England - St George and really enjoyed hearing about his story fighting the dragon. The children wrote the beginning and middle of the story using the teacher as a scribe, they then chose their own ending to the story - do come in and have a look at their great ideas which are in their topic books.

In science this week we have been learning about the different names for animals young and learnt some new interesting ones.

On our second Friday morning 'Woodland Explorers' session down at the field and woodland area we were blessed with lovely sunshine. We reinforced our rules of 'Don't lick it, don't pick it, don't squish it' which are great rules for all of life. We had fun litter picking, helping our community and had a go at hide and seek but still not enough cover! The Year 1 children did some maths using natural materials as they worked on arrays with Mrs Beardshaw. They also had a go at dirt drawing - tricky but fun!
