The children then thought about what superhero they would like to be, what they would be called and what their super powers would be.

The children continue on their phonic and reading journeys and the practise they are doing at home really does make a huge difference so thanks as always for your support with this. We are helping them transfer their great reading skills into their writing by saying words and then segmenting these into their sounds and then writing those sounds down. We have had a few headteachers awards this week for their efforts.

We continue to practise our handwriting in their families, encouraging the children to think about their pencil grips, sitting position and anchoring the paper correctly as well as working on how to form those letters.

We have enjoyed the sunny weather with lots of outdoor activities to support the work within the classroom.

We celebrated World Earth Day - thinking about what we love about our world and learning about ways we can help look after it.

We learnt about the patron saint of England - St George and really enjoyed hearing about his story fighting the dragon. We made our own painting of this story and wrote about our favourite part. We also made a fork dragon to take home to share with our families to remind us of the story.

We went on a visit to our church St Anne's and were so interested and excited to find out more about this special place. As well as learning lots of new vocabulary in identifying the different areas of the church we also all got to have a go at playing the organ - do see our fabulous photos. On our second Friday morning 'Woodland Explorers' session down at the field and woodland area we were blessed with lovely sunshine. We reinforced our rules of 'Don't lick it, don't pick it, don't squish it' which are great rules for all of life. We had fun litter picking, helping our community and had a go at acting out the story Jack and the Beanstalk. The EYFS children did some great counting by collecting different natural materials. They also had a go at dirt drawing - tricky but fun!
