### Week 3 Summer 1 2026

We continued looking at our new topic 'Our Wonderful World' as we followed up the great experiences the children have had over the past two weeks on their exploration of Baslow.

After a chat about different types of houses, where the children learnt new terms to describe the houses we see, they each chose a building from Baslow to create as a 3D model. The children all worked really hard on their model and the results can be seen on the display in Tigers.

The children continue to work on their sizing and position in their handwriting using the extra lines in their handwriting books, this week they have been looking at the robot arm family and sloping letter family.

In science this week we have been learning about the weather, finding out about weather symbols, how to record weather and how it affects our everyday lives. We looked at some of the instruments that are used to record the weather and the children made their own wind indicator using a stick and recycled plastic. They took this home with a sheet to record the weather over the next week. We will then be looking to see what information we can gather from their recordings.

On our third Friday morning 'Woodland Explorers' session down at the field and woodland area we were blessed with lovely sunshine. We reinforced our rules of 'Don't lick it, don't pick it, don't squish it' which are great rules for all of life. We had fun litter picking, helping our community. The children were introduced to orienteering and had a go for the very first time which was great fun. They also had a go at creating a portrait using natural materials. We had great fun in the playground and with the large parachute, the children are beginning to realise that team work is definitely needed if they are to be able to play properly. These skills are ones we reinforce daily with the extensive use of our outside space at school - definitely helped this week by some lovely sunshine!
