We have continued work on our topic 'Superheroes', this week the children have finished creating their superhero, thinking about their weaknesses and where they got their powers from. They then wrote a story about their superhero using an adult as a scribe. This meant they could really use their imaginations. These stories have been made into a book for them to share with their Year 1 friends. They also painted a picture of their superhero and will write about this next week. Do come and look at the class display which has some of their amazing work.

This week's handwriting family has been the sloping letter family and as always we have encouraged them to think about their pencil grips, sitting position and anchoring the paper correctly as well as working on how to form those letters.

In maths this week we have been looking at simple addition and subtraction problems, using objects or drawing pictures to help consolidate that understanding. We have also been able to introduce the concept of counting on or back to solve these problems - again by using ourselves and jumping on or back on giant number tracks.

On our third Friday morning 'Woodland Explorers' session down at the field and woodland area we were blessed with lovely sunshine. We reinforced our rules of 'Don't lick it, don't pick it, don't squish it' which are great rules for all of life. We had fun litter picking, helping our community and had a go at acting out the story The Three Little Pigs. The EYFS children went on a search to find and match up pictures of animals and their young and then had a go at creating a portrait using natural materials around them. We had great fun in the playground and with the large parachute, the children are beginning to realise that team work is definitely need if they are to be able to play properly. These skills are ones we reinforce daily with the extensive use of our outside space at school - definitely helped this week by some lovely sunshine!
