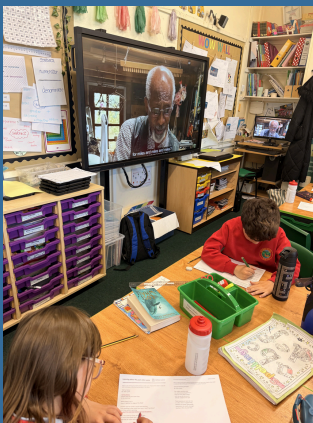


# CLASS 3 NEWSLETTER

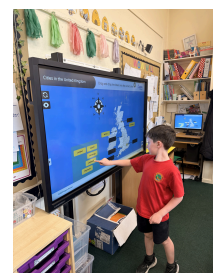
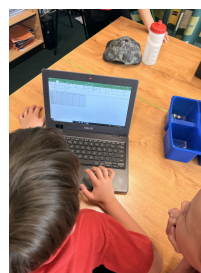
In maths, we have been finishing off our topic of money and starting our shape topic with angles and turns. We described how to get to different numbers on the number square using turns and directions.
