The children continue to work really hard on their letter formation, this week we have been focussing on the robot arm letters. We encourage them to use these in our writing. They are all working so hard on using their fantastic reading knowledge in their writing - do pop in at Open Door and have a look.

In our topic 'Under the Sea' the children created an under the sea scene and discussed what animals they recognised. They have also painted a picture of something they would like to do at the seaside and next week will write about their painting. After the disappointment of no sports day due to the weather we went on a virtual visit to the seaside and afterwards introduced the children to postcards and they wrote a postcard about their visit.

We have also started to think about Father's Day and how it is celebrated around the world.

The children have made their cards and begun work on their gift.

In maths this week we have been looking at odd and even numbers and also been looking at movement and direction, including thinking about our left and right. We had great fun playing outside using directions of moving forward, backward, left and right and then brought that vocabulary into the classroom to use with the beebots. It was great fun.

In our work on Understanding the World we looked at a variety of objects and thought about what they are used for and what they are made out of. We then collected four different materials and used our writing skills to name the materials they are made out of.

Friday was at school this week as it was class photo day, again greatly enjoyed by the children. We then had a morning of exploring stories from the bible and beginning to think about what we know about religions. This led to some really interesting discussions.

Next week we hope for some better weather and look forward to sports day and being back in the woods on Friday.
