As part of our topic we have been exploring the animals that you might find under the sea, the children chose an animal they would like to find out about. We explored how we find out information using a variety of sources, including asking each other, asking the adults who help us, looking in books or searching on line. This enabled us to reinforce our work on keeping ourselves on line, they will continue to look at how to stay safe online in their work with Mrs Hayes on computing over this term. The children then created their own simple fact file about their animal. They shared their findings with their friends. Do pop in and see their work in their topic books at Open Door.

We have also started to think about Father's Day and how it is celebrated around the world. The children have made their cards and begun work on their gift.

In science the children have looked at identifying different objects and then working out what material they are made out of. They identified a range of different common objects and then sorted them into the materials they are made out of.
